How patients can enroll in Medicaid*


- NH DHHS determines who qualifies for NH Medicaid

- Individuals can apply for themselves or a family member using the NH EASY online application system (www.dhhs.nh.gov)
- Members will have an annual re-determination through DHHS

Care Management Programs

- Well Sense members who need help managing their special health conditions will be able to participate in a care management program to get help learning to manage their particular condition, such as asthma, diabetes, and pregnancy.
- Our Care Management staff will work with members to:
 - -help them understand their disease or condition
 - -enroll in our Care Management Select program if they are struggling with serious and complicated health conditions





Sunny Start

- Care management program that helps moms and babies get the care they need during and after pregnancy
- Members who enroll in the program get help from Care Management staff, including:
 - -Customized care planning
 - -Assistance from nurses skilled in obstetrics
 - -Assistance related to post partum care
 - -Connecting to community resources & applying for WIC
